INTRODUCTION

The Night of Love vigil of reparation is a response to Our Lord's request that reparation for the sins of mankind be made to His Sacred Heart and the Immaculate Heart, specifically on first Fridays and first Saturdays.

Our Lord, who in 1674 began appearing to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque and asked for Communions of Reparation on the First Fridays, later requested in the apparitions at Fatima, that the Communions of Reparation on First Saturdays be established throughout the world. He told Sister Lucia in the chapel at Pontevedra in 1925: "Have pity on the Heart of your most holy Mother, covered with thorns, with which ungrateful men pierce it at every moment and there is no one to make an act of reparation to remove them. I desire that the devotion to the Immaculate Heart of My Mother be placed alongside devotion to My Sacred Heart."

A night vigil of reparation from First Friday evening to the First Saturday morning, developed from the Blue Army of Our Lady of Fatima, in 1969, as an ideal response to the Hearts of Jesus and Mary for reparation, and to place their devotion alongside each other. It fulfills Our Lord's request of St. Margaret Mary to receive Holy Communion worthily and for a one-hour vigil on First Fridays in reparation, and Our Lady's request for reparation on First Saturdays to her Immaculate Heart by going to confession, receiving Holy Communion, praying the Rosary and meditating for 15 minutes on the other mysteries of the Rosary.

And while the Sacred Hearts asked for only an hour on each of those days, generous souls in our particularly unfaithful times cry out, "O beloved Hearts of my Savior and my Mother, not just an hour, but an entire night!" (St. John Eudes).

Today, in response to the growing number of Catholics who have fallen away from the Church and belief in the Real Presence of Jesus, the World Apostolate of Fatima, USA, (Our Lady's Blue Army) is asking parishes and dioceses to revisit the night vigil of reparation as a sacrifice of love to Our Lord and Our Lady. We invite you to come together as the Body of Christ on earth before the Eucharistic Body and Blood of Jesus, imploring His mercy and grace upon the Church and its members who have walked away, and on those who refuse His love and mercy. We offer this in union with our bishops and in support of their efforts at evangelizing the Faith to a post-Christian, secular world.

Some parishes may wish to continue with silent adoration through the night. Adjustments may be made as necessary which better correspond to the customs or practices of the parish or other location where the Vigil is being held.

FORMULA OF ENROLLMENT AND BLESSING OF THE BROWN SCAPULAR OF OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL

V: Show us, O Lord, Thy mercy.

R: And grant us Thy salvation.

V: O Lord, hear my prayer.

R: And let my cry come unto Thee.

V: The Lord be with you.

R: And with your spirit.

V: Let us pray. O Lord Jesus Christ, Savior of mankind, by Thy right hand sanctify † these Scapulars (this Scapular) which Thy servants will devoutly wear for the love of Thee and of Thy Mother; the Blessed Virgin Mary of Mt. Carmel; so that, by her intercession, they may be protected from the wickedness of the enemy and persevere in Thy grace until death; Who livest and reignest for ever and ever.

R: Amen.

The priest now sprinkles the Scapular with holy water, after which he places the Scapular on each one saying:

V: Receive this blessed Scapular and ask the Most Holy Virgin that, by her merits, it may be worn with no stain of sin and may protect you from all harm and bring you into everlasting life.

R: Amen.

V: May Almighty God, Creator of Heaven and earth, bless you whom He has been pleased to receive into the Confraternity of the Blessed Virgin Mary of Mount Carmel. We beg her to crush the head of the ancient serpent in the hour of your death, and, in the end, to obtain for you a palm and the crown of your everlasting inheritance. Through Christ our Lord.

R: Amen.

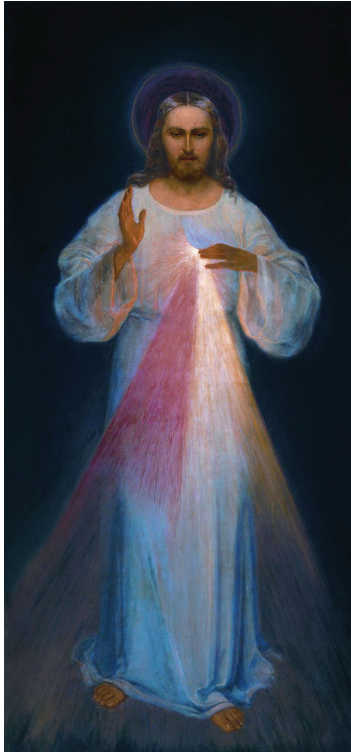
