The National Eucharistic Revival is a tremendous opportunity to draw fallen-away Catholics back to the faith and belief in the real presence of Our Lord Jesus in the Eucharist. As the head of the Eucharistic Revival, Bishop Andrew Cozzens has endorsed this initiative, and a letter and packet of information has also been mailed to the bishops in every diocese.

Plan a Vigil

Materials are free at bluearmy.com/night-of-love/ to help you plan and promote a vigil. Our downloadable booklet, condensed from the original book *Night of Love*, contains a suggested schedule, prayers and devotions, and a short background on how these night vigils sprang from Fatima and spread across the country by our apostolate in the 1960s. Many parishes still hold them monthly on the night of First Friday/First Saturday. Other FREE materials include a downloadable poster and song sheets, and an interactive map to register your Night of Love.
